For men's mental health awareness month, Jake Nuttall has been doing 245 press ups every day during the month of June. He completed his challenge on the 28th of June with 5642 press ups in total, a figure that represents the number of male suicides last year. This was a tough challenge, but Jake found that it helped him to manage his own emotions during his GCSE exams and he enjoyed putting daily evidence blogs together and sharing them on social media.

Jake wanted to pass on his gratitude to all the BBS families that offered him kind words of encouragement and for their donations to the Samaritan's charity. He is delighted to share that his efforts raised a massive £1360 and is hopeful that this money will fund the Samaritans to continue to provide valuable support and help to reduce male suicide in the future.
