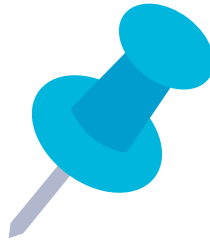

# Parent Pay from ScoPay

# COMING SOON

## Online payments to school with ParentPay!

Following the **end of the Autumn Term** we will be replacing **ScoPay** as our **online payment system** for school meals, and other school items and will be changing to the secure service called **ParentPay**.

**ParentPay** will go **live** at school on the **21st December 2024**. Any balances left on your ScoPay account, will be transferred over to ParentPay. As you are aware, we **no longer accept cash** in school but if your situation is that you need a cash facility, then you can do so by using the **PayPoint network** at **local convenience stores**.

You will have a **secure online account**, activated using a unique **username** and **password**; you will be prompted to change these, and to keep them **safe** and **secure**. If you have **more than one child** at our school, or children at other ParentPay schools, you can **create a single account login for all your children**.

Making a payment is straightforward and ParentPay holds a **payment history** for you to view later; **no card details are stored** in any part of the system. Once you have activated your account you can make online payments straight away.

PayPoint payments are recorded by ParentPay and can be seen by logging into your ParentPay account and viewing your payment history online. **Please notify the Finance Office if you wish to use the PayPoint facility**. A plastic card will be issued to you to make cash payments for school meals at local PayPoint stores. **PayPoint cards take about two weeks to arrive**. Whilst waiting for your card to arrive, a barcode letter can be issued as an interim measure.

Your support in using ParentPay will help the school enormously, thank you. For more **information** and **FAQ's** please see the letter on our website that has been uploaded with this week's bulletin.

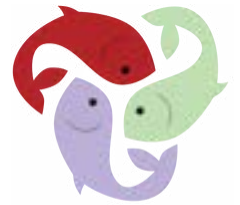

Thank you for your **continued support**. We look forward to celebrating the **festive season** with our **school community**.

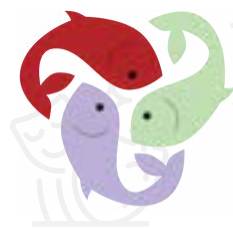
