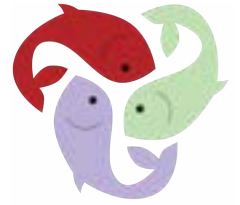

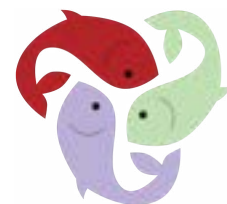

Enjoy your well-deserved break, and I can't wait to see you all in the new year!







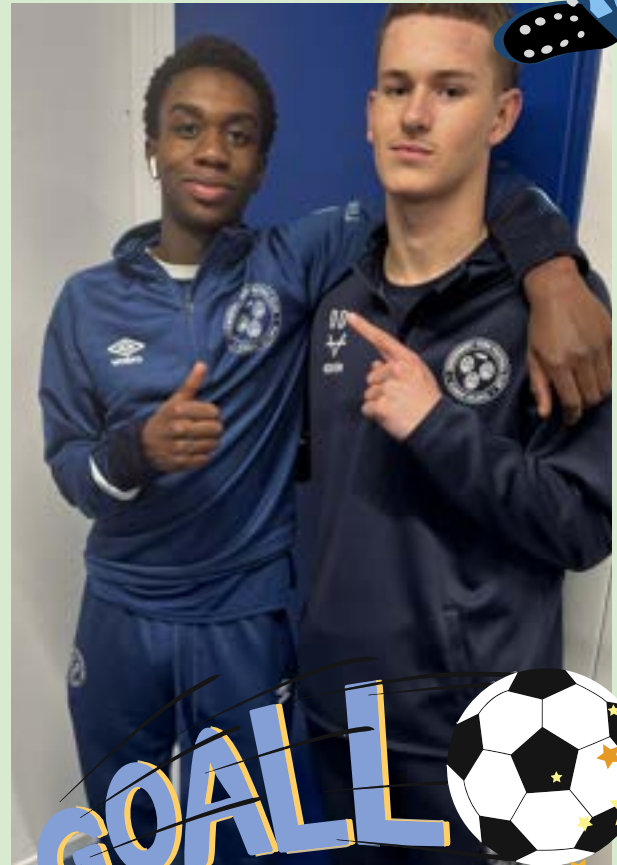
