Making Paella

Year 9 have been making **Paella** this week in their food lessons. **Well done year 9 - it looks delicious!**



RECIPE

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 tbsp** Vegetable Oil
- 1** Small Chorizo
- Sausages, Cut into slices
- 1** Onion, sliced
- 1** Garlic Clove, Chopped
- 1/2 tsp** turmeric
- 300g** plain rice
- 200g** raw chicken
- 100g** frozen peas
- 1** chicken stock cube
- Lemon wedges to serve

EQUIPMENT:

- 1** Wooden Spoon
- 1** Red Chopping Board
- 1** Jug
- 1** Sharp Knife

HOW TO MAKE:

1. Heat a **tablespoon of oil** over a **medium heat**. Add the sliced onion and garlic cook till soft.
2. Make **500ml of stock** with hot water.
3. Add the **sliced chorizo** and **thinly slices chicken**.
4. Add the **turmeric** and rice and stir.
5. Add **peas and stock**. Cook on a simmer till the rice is cooked, more hot water can be added at this point if needed.
8. Serve with **lemon wedges**.
