## **Phonics**

Term 1 – Complete phase 2

Term 2 – Recap phase 2 and begin phase 3

Term 3 – Recap phase 2 and 3, assess the children and begin phase 4 with the children that are ready.

## **Literacy**

Term 1 – Children can write their names, simple captions and be able to hear and say the initial sound in a word.

- Term 2 Children to use phonics knowledge to sound out simple words and begin to write sentences.
- Term 3 Children to write for a purpose and write sentences independently.

## **Maths**

Term 1 – We will look at subitising within 5, developing 1:1 counting of objects, actions and sounds, exploring the composition of numbers through part part whole and comparing sets of objects. Throughout maths lessons there will also be a focus on developing children's mathematical vocabulary.

Term 2 – We will continue to look at subitising using patterns and explore symmetrical patterns to explore doubles. We will continue to develop verbal counting to 20 and beyond as well as continuing to develop object counting skills, using a range of strategies to develop accuracy. Children will begin to see that numbers within 10 can be composed of '5 and a bit', explore the composition of numbers within 10 and begin to explore odd/even numbers.

Term 3 – Children will continue to develop their ability to subitise, they will be encouraged to identify when it is appropriate to count and when groups can be subitised. They will continue to develop verbal counting to 20 and beyond, including counting from different starting numbers. We will explore the composition of 10. We will look at ordering sets of objects, linking this to the children's understanding of the ordinal number system.
