SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT

Through the teaching of MFL children are given the opportunity to look at the belief and traditions of people in France. They are given the opportunity to reflect on how these beliefs /traditions may be similar/different to their own. As well as teaching the language of French, children are also taught about life in France. Children are encouraged and supported to reflect on their learning of French through using the 'I Can' tracking clouds at the end of each unit of learning.

MORAL DEVELOPMENT

The teaching of MFL encourages children to have respect for other people, their language and culture.

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

MFL lessons provide the opportunities for children to work with partners/small groups. This encourages co-operation with others and listening to and discussing the ideas of others. MFL gives children the opportunity to explore language, beliefs and a culture that is different to their own. This supports children to respect those with different faiths and beliefs.

CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT

Through the teaching of MFL children explore the French language and can see how some French words are like English words. They come across French words that have been adopted by the English language. Children look at a culture that is different to their own through MFL lessons. The language curriculum enables children to look at words that French/English have in common. Children also learn about celebrations in France, and they reflect on how these are similar to their own.
