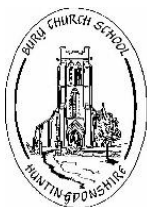

This will take place on Tuesday 7th October at 2.45pm. Please come through the main office.



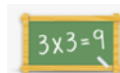
Y3/Y4 Burwell House residential trip:
