Y6 SATS:

No Celebration Assembly on Friday 23rd May:



Due to Sports Day being held on Friday 23rd May, there will be no Celebration Assembly that day. Birthdays between 12th May and 1st June (inclusive) will be celebrated in a Celebration Assembly **next Friday (16th May)**. Parents/carers are welcome to attend.

Y6 Come to Lunch:



This is taking place next Friday (16th May). Parents/carers are invited to arrive at 11.40am. Hot meal orders have now closed so if you would like to come along, please bring a packed lunch (please still complete the form or contact the office to advise us of your attendance). **Please could we ask that parents/carers do not bring hot drinks into school with them. We also ask that younger siblings do not attend these 'Come to Lunch' sessions.**

FoBS Discos:



A reminder that the FoBS school discos will take place next Friday 16th May. Reception and KS1 (Years 1 and 2) disco will be 5.00-6.00pm (please note, **parents are not required to stay**). £3 payable on the door, to include a drink and snack.

KS2 (Years 3-6) disco will be 6.10pm-7.10pm (again, children can be dropped off). The cost for KS2 children will be £1.50 payable on the door and then children are welcome to bring additional money to purchase snacks/drinks from a tuck shop. As a guide, items will cost between 50p and £1.
