Y1 Come to Lunch:



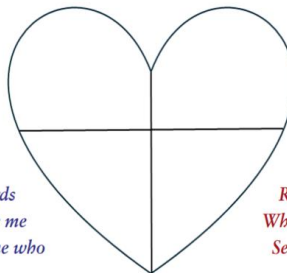
