4.0	Future Events – 2022 Calendar	
4.1	Summer BBQ – Tickets are to be sold for this event due to the unpredictability of the weather, if we need to move inside or use gazebos we need to know numbers in advance. The date is set for 17 th June 2022, school will sort posters etc where required.	

4.2	Disco Night & Movie Night – Emma Heanes to discuss with Fran when the School Hall will be available.	EH
4.3	2022 Fund Raiser – Raising £20.22 in 2022 This will launch on 22 March and will run through until just after the Easter Holidays. Individuals, siblings, groups, families to get sponsored to do something, anything to raise £20.22.	
4.4	Discussed the option of a 'Break the Rules' Day (renamed) – Emma Heanes felt this may not be an option because of frequent Non School Uniform days and money being raised for that.	
4.5	A 'Glitter Ball' is being held on December 3 rd 2022. This will be at the Old Nene Golf Course. It will include a 3-course meal, live music and an auction. The cost will be £55 per ticket, the event will be advertised to Bury School Families first and then to the wider community. We will need to sell 100 tickets in total.	
4.6	School Uniform Sales – Looking to have an after-school sale stall towards the end of term outside the front of school.	
4.7	Queen's Jubilee – As part of this event Asda are prepared to give out between £500 and £1500 if we can provide them with evidence that we have done something to benefit the school. Kirsty shared the idea of a lapel badge or we could look to give all the children a commemorative coin like we did before. Michaela to investigate the options and see what the cost would be for each child and member of staff at the school. We would need to do something in school before half term to be able to present Asda with the evidence they require for them to give us some funds. Perhaps something like 'Bring Your Grandparent To Tea'? or a mock coronation. Everyone to keep an eye out for anything the shops are selling off/getting rid of once the Jubilee celebrations are over.
