

Curriculum Overview - KS4 Art & Photography

- Develop students as confident, independent artists and photographers who can experiment, refine and present creative work.
- Encourage exploration of a broad range of media, materials and techniques across fine art and lens-based media.
- Build visual literacy and cultural awareness, linking work to historical and contemporary artists/photographers.
- Teach students to analyse, reflect and evaluate, improving their own work and understanding others'.
- Prepare students for further creative study or careers by giving them professional-style experiences (portfolio, exhibitions, critiques).
- Embed the academy's aims: globally aware, culturally aware, self-aware, ambitious and work-ready.

	 Independent development of ideas from chosen theme.
	Photography: studio lighting, portraiture, editing.
	Fine art: larger scale, mixed media, experimental.
	Portfolio selection and refinement.
Spring	Externally Set Assignment (ESA)
	Respond to exam board theme.
	Research, record, experiment, refine ideas.
	 10-hour exam preparation: sketchbook build-up, artist links, test pieces.
Summer	ESA Final Exam & Submission
	 Produce final piece under exam conditions (10 hours).
	Final portfolio submission of coursework and ESA.
	Curate assessment-ready body of work.
