Little Chicks

We have been...

- Reading different versions of the Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs and The Princess and the Pea stories
- Dressing up as princesses, princes and knights
- Looking in the 'Magic Mirror' and saying the special words!
- Drawing who or what we can see in the mirror
- Listening to and matching rhyming words/pictures
- Comparing two groups of numbers and recognising how an amount stays the same even when you separate it into different groups

Ducklings

We have been...

- Reading, sequencing and retelling the Snow White and the seven dwarfs, The Princess and the Pea and The Paper Bag Princess stories
- Writing about what makes them special when they look in the 'magic' mirror and thinking of interesting words to describe a dragon
- Describing what princess bed covers, made out different materials, feel like and investigating how many mattresses it takes before they can no longer feel the pea
- Learning how to add by counting groups of objects altogether and then by counting on
- Investigating different ways to add to make 5 or 10
- In Phonics we have been learning the phonemes j, v, w, x, y and z and practising handwriting them cursively and blending to read words with them in



<u>Our Learning</u>

The Ducklings and Little Chicks interests have now led us to plan our learning about prince and princess stories with dragons in! We will start by reading Zog and then lots of other different dragon themed stories. We hope to give our writing and descriptions of dragons to a children's illustrator (and parent!) so that they can read our super describing words and create our very own class dragon for us! We will be making dragons, small and large scale using different techniques, tools and materials.

In mathematics the Ducklings will be exploring using money, naming the coins, using them to pay for different amounts and exploring different ways to make the same amount with different coins. The Little Chicks are going to be exploring and hunting for different shapes and using shapes to make pictures and patterns.

We will be investigating how to free a dragon from being frozen in ice and practise our physical skills by rolling balls at dragon themed skittle targets.

Following on from learning about dragons we will explore knights and castles.

We hope to have a special day to end our topic on Thursday 14th February, a Knights, princes and princesses day with lots of fun activities. The children will be able to come dressed up on this day, so we wanted to give you plenty of notice to get your costumes together!
