Little Chicks

We have been...

- Enjoying reading lots of different versions of the Goldilocks and the Three Bears and Little Red Riding Hood stories and joining in with the story telling
- Comparing quantities, counting to 5 and beyond and recognising numbers to 5
- The children have been doing really well learning the Christmas play songs and joining in with rehearsals

Ducklings

We have been...

- Reading and retelling different Goldilocks and Little Red Riding Hood stories, using the familiar story language
- Making porridge, eating it with different toppings and helping Goldilocks to make her own porridge by writing all about it
- Making different sized bears, chairs and beds in the creative area
- Hiding our bears and using positional vocabulary to describe where they were hiding
- Counting accurately the buns to take to Grandma's house



Our Learning

Over the remaining weeks we will be learning all about Christmas and joining in with the season's celebrations. Next week we will be continuing to practise our nativity play ready for our dress rehearsal and then our performances the following week. Next week we will be focusing on the nativity story and why Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus. We will be retelling and ordering the events in the nativity story, as well as dressing up in

nativity costumes to act it out! We will be busy making our natural decorations ready for the Christmas fair and busy creating our own Christmas cards and crafts. The following week we will be finding out about how Christmas is celebrated in our homes and around the world. We will talk about how different families have different traditions. Our home corner and role play areas will be decorated and turned into Christmas at home.

Little Chicks will continue with their number work, comparing quantities, counting and recognising numbers. They will also be exploring the sounds 's' and 'a' and finding objects that begin with these sounds.

The Ducklings will be completing this phase of phonics and learning the phonemes - I, II and ss. As our first term at school draws to an end, the Ducklings' teachers will also be finding out what the children have learnt and remembered so far in phonics, reading, writing and mathematics by completing assessment activities with them,

How can you help at home?

Little Chicks

Read some different nativity stories together

Practise counting objects around the home

Listen out for objects around the home that begin with the 's' or 'a' sound

Ducklings

Talk for Mathematics

Practise counting collections of objects up to 20 accurately

Practise writing numbers to 20 in different ways – outside with chalk on the path, with a stick in the sand or mud, in a tray of rice or flour!

Look at numbers on doors. Which number would be 1 more or 1 less?

Estimate how many objects are in a group and then check by counting

Talk for Reading and Writing

Find objects when you are at home and out and about that start with the sounds b,f and l.

Look out for words that have a double letter in like ff, ss or II, such as miss or will

Practise writing these letters in sand or with chalk

Look for these letters in books at home.

Practise reading and writing the phase 2 'tricky' words - I, go, no, to, the and into. Look for these tricky words in your reading books and books at home

Watch Geraldine the Giraffe (+ the letter/sound) – phonics clips and watch and sing the Jolly Phonics songs on YouTube

Write the message in your Christmas cards, using your cursive handwriting!
