Reminders

Wellies and Puddle Suits- If you haven't yet sent in a pair of wellies for your child or a puddle suit, please can you do so as soon as possible? The children learn outdoors every day and in all weathers!

<u>Names</u> - Please make sure that all items of uniform, coats and other belongings, including shoes are named.

<u>Our Families Wall</u> - We would love to celebrate and share all of our families together by having a family photograph wall in our own home corner. It would be lovely if each child could bring in a family photograph (which we can copy and return) or email it in to your child's class teacher. Many thanks!

<u>Snack Time</u> - Please be aware that we are a nut-free school and therefore we ask that any snacks brought in are free from nuts, including in packed lunches. We are also a healthy school and ask that children only bring in <u>fruit or vegetables</u> and not fruit winders, etc. We also ask that children bring just water in their bottles. Please carry water bottles, rather than putting them inside their book bags. Each child receives an item of fruit provided by school each day. You know your child best and over the next few weeks will be able to decide whether or not you need to send them in with an additional snack. They will probably not need more than one snack bringing in from home each day. If sending grapes into school for snack, please make sure that they are cut in half lengthways to prevent choking.

<u>Spare Clothes</u> - Please can children attending Little Chicks make sure that they come with a bag that has a change of clothes in each day? Thank you.

<u>School Milk</u> - All Little Chicks and Ducklings are entitled to free school milk, until the term that they turn 5 years old. After turning 5, the children need to be registered with Cool Milk and pay to receive this. You can register at www.coolmilk.com/ once they turn 5.

<u>Play Area</u> - We ask that children refrain from using the play area, on the playground, before and after school. Thank you.

<u>Medical Appointments</u> - If a child has to attend an appointment during school hours, please forward a copy of the appointment letter to Mr Fish in the school office to support our registers. d.fish@carletongreen.lancs.sch.uk
