Trip Money Update

The deadline for making your contribution towards your child's enhanced learning opportunities is 31st December.

Last year we had to cancel planned trips and I faced many complaints about the children understandably being disappointed. This year we have planned and shared the intended purpose of the events, giving time for payments to be made. We are still facing a massive shortfall (£1980) If you haven't yet paid for your child, please can you do so at your earliest opportunity? School has a limited budget and we plan very careful use of it to ensure that all our children get the very best experience at our school. We factor in the cost of trips hoping that contributions will be made.

Some children have already attended a trip with no contribution towards the cost having been made or any contact made to school to request some financial assistance. We would not go to a shop and not expect pay for an item and, so I do not understand how this keeps happening. Please help!
