The House that raises the most money will earn 50 points towards Sports' Day.

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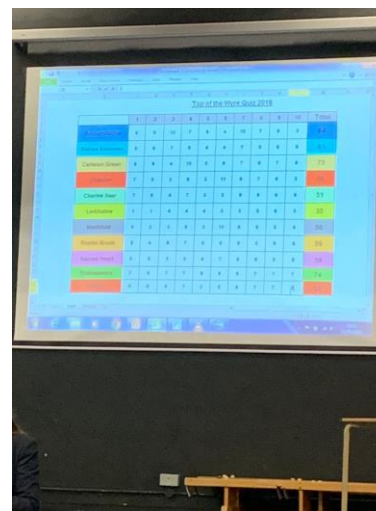
