On Tuesday we had confirmation that our year 6 pupils have achieved really well in their SATs of which we are incredibly proud. Attainment and the progress our pupils make at Carleton Green is improving every year which is obviously our aim! The children and our teachers have worked very hard and deserve the accolades that come with such great scores!

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar ~ 82.6% of our pupils achieved the expected standard at least with 43.4% of these achieving the higher level.

Reading ~ 89% of our pupils achieved the expected standard at least with 26% of these achieving the higher level.

Writing ~ 85% of our pupils achieved the expected standard at least with 35% of these achieving the higher level.

Maths ~ 91% of our pupils achieved the expected standard at least with 54.3% of these achieving the higher level.

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The Got to Dance and Voice and Musician of the Year evenings were once again very special events. The children that were able to take part in these demonstrated such talent and confidence. Poppy Roberts was this year's winner for Got to Dance with Marcus Wright earning the top place for Musician of the Year. Our very talented Robyn Newby received first place for the Voice of the Year.

We have ended our week with children in Year Five presenting to the rest of the school ways they feel they would be a good choice for our next year's Head and Deputy roles. To aspire and apply for such a position in Primary School is tremendous and I was very pleased to see how many children had considered themselves suitable.
