Positive reinforcement and great home-school links will often help and eliminate the difficulties encountered at school. It is sadly inevitable that children will be exposed to some unacceptable behaviour at some point in their school lives but what we at Carleton Green ensure is, that they know it is not alright and can see we intervene. Our behaviour policy is on our website with a full explanation of acceptable and unacceptable behaviours. All children are entitled to their learning but it can never be at the detriment to others and so we will always remove children from classes if they are disturbing the learning for others.

On Saturday 26th October at 7pm, there is to be a fabulous live show called "A Million Dreams" which is a tribute to The Greatest Showman plus a family disco set afterwards held at Vicarage Park Community Centre in Poulton.
