Our key worker group have remained in school with provision for care continuing as it has since March 20<sup>th</sup>. I have managed to keep my team safe and the children by initially sharing with our local schools as well as continuing to maintain a skeleton team for each day. This coming week we are to place our key worker children into bubbles to help for when school does open again and reduce the risk of cross contamination further. We ask that all our families support our endeavours to keep all safe and well, in maintaining social distancing when at home. I have amended our home school agreement to reflect this requirement.
