Although the sunshine has gone for a while we have enjoyed another week at school. During the past fortnight we saw the number of children attending rise across school. The care that has gone into ensuring a safe return has been evident and reflects considerable hard work from all involved. It has been an absolute privilege to welcome back the groups from the other year groups for their hour visits. I cannot wait to see the rest of the children from years 2-5. During the remaining weeks of this term we will continue to work closely with the DFE to plan for full opening in September in line with the current national ambition along with providing Breakfast and Afterschool provision too.

Provision during the Summer Holidays 2020 ~ Fleetwood Town have been able to confirm that they are to help provide care for four weeks during August for our Key Worker children. They are to provide details nearer the time, operating a booking form as we have done throughout the 'closure'. Free school meal vouchers will be sent on the 20th July to cover the 6 weeks holiday period and will cease in September.

End of Year reports will be sent home today (between 16:30 & 17:00) which report on your child's learning for the period from September 2019 and March 2020. Normally, we would invite parents to a drop-in session to discuss any element but this year we ask that you email the class teacher or myself with any query. I ask that should you email you do so within the school working week please.

How It Works

Shout is the UK's first free 24/7 crisis text line available for anyone, anytime, anywhere. The service is anonymous and off bill. It is powered by a nationwide team of Crisis Volunteers, supported by expert Clinical Supervisors. This is a place to go if you're experiencing a personal crisis, unable to cope and need immediate help.

- 1 Text**

Text **SHOUT** to **85258** from anywhere in the UK, 24/7.
- 2 Connect**

After 3 automated responses, you'll connect with a trained Crisis Volunteer who receives the text on their computer - this will usually be in around 5 minutes but will take longer during busy times.
- 3 Chat**

You can text about whatever is a personal crisis to you - this might include issues like addiction, anxiety, assault, bullying, depression, eating disorders, relationship challenges, self-harm and suicide.
- 4 Share**

The Crisis Volunteer listens without judgement, invites you to share more, and helps you move from a hot moment to a calm one. You'll text back and forth, sharing only what you feel comfortable.
- 5 Action**

The goal of the conversation is to help you reach a calm and safe place, ideally with a plan of how to support yourself going forward. As well as listening, resources to help you get more expert support or tools to help you manage might be shared.
- 6 Calm**

The conversation will only end when the Crisis Volunteer is comfortable that you are in a calm and safe place.
