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The online forms will be live from today Friday 9th October and will close on Thursday 15th October. From Friday 16th October class teachers will email out your given time slots. The email addresses that we will use will be the ones that are detailed on your child's school contact form. If you need these updating, please contact the office. Once you have been emailed your time slot/s, you will need to download the Zoom app and add your class teacher/s as a contact using their school email address. Class teachers will then accept your contact request. On the evening of your given time the class teacher will invite you to a video call. These video calls will last 5 minutes (as they would normally do in the school hall) so that teachers can make their next video call. We ask that you do not 'call' your class teacher but wait for them to call you. This is so it does not interfere with any other video calls that may be taking place. Due to GDPR class teachers cannot send links or passcodes out to join a call. They will always ring you at your given time.

When making appointments for siblings please allow at least 10 minutes in between each appointment. As this is our first time using Zoom to hold parents' evenings, please be patient with us!

Reminder: Please can you pick up your children from the designated spaces but walk around the front of school rather than across our grounds to save congestion?

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
