School Development

- To raise standards further by ensuring we have very clear expected outcomes planned for each term and individual lesson.
- To improve school attendance so it is higher than 97% Attendance and Punctuality have to be reported to the Local Authority along with school discussing with the governing board every term. It is really important that appointments and holidays are kept outside of the school opening hours. Although we highly value the importance of family time please note that we are not able to authorise any absence from school that is taken for a holiday.
- To improve outdoor facilities ~ the play area for our younger children is in the process of being designed. We are looking forward to this part of school being completed so that the children can practise vital gross motor skills whilst having lots of fun with their friends. Outdoor learning is to take place every week
- To further develop our links with families and the community by strengthening our PTFA (Helping Hands)
- Rolling programmes of maintenance - Painting the shared spaces within school, replacing windows and doors, replacing fascia's
