The classes have all enjoyed participating in their outdoor learning this week where they have been harvesting the seeds from flowers. These will be used to create seed bombs to then make a meadow at the front of school. If anyone has wild flower seeds they would like to donate we would be very grateful. The older classes have been testing the PH of the soil around school to know what will grow best in different places. We ideally want to rebuild our greenhouse and so will start collecting plastic bottles. To re-create the greenhouse that was vandalised we will certainly need some help from willing parents. This time we would like it housing at the front of our school.

As a school we are making a significant move towards no single use plastic and so ask that packed lunches contain as little plastic as possible. We are to collect rubbish in from each class to see how much waste we create over a week.

We are thrilled to be able to make plans to take out Year 5 and Year 6 children away this year and finally go on trips. I know that our Lower KS2 phase are busy planning a trip to enhance their learning about the Egyptians – information is to come soon. We have secure bookings at Waterpark for our pupils in Year 5 where they will carry out activities at the fabulous outdoor education centre in the day and camp under canvas at night. These are set to take place on the 21st and 22nd June 2022. Details are to be sent home next week. Our Year 6 pupils will also get to go to Waterpark and stay in the gorgeous manor house sited on Lake Coniston. Again, a letter which outlines the residential in more detail is to be sent home next week. The dates for this exciting trip are from Monday 11th July – Friday 15th July 2022. This planned 'holiday' is either three days long or is five days dependant upon the uptake of interest.
