Back to school on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2023.

It was lovely to see so many of our children attending the Remembrance Service in Poulton on Sunday. Well done to those parading in uniform as well as our Heads and Deputies for presenting a wreath from school. Fleetwood Town would like to provide an additional holiday club this Christmas due to school's breaking up a week ahead of Christmas Day. Being a Community Primary School, we believe in using our facilities to support our local community. This additional club will run for the first 4 days of the break.

It has been a busy week with lots of activities taking place outside of the usual learning. Bikeability, for half of the Year 6 pupils, began this week with the remaining half booked in to complete next week.

These events always prove to be challenging in more ways than one – the length of the day, performing in front of a live audience in a strange environment. The children as always, made us very proud.
