Over the next few months, we are looking forward to welcoming visitors from 'Building Bridges' which is an organisation that visits schools across the county to support the teaching and learning of Religious Education.

These visits are organised through Lancashire SACRE (Standing Advisory Council on Religious Education) who plan our RE curriculum. The visitors will be sharing their experiences of their faith. These visits bring the curriculum alive and promote community cohesion, because our visitors are able to speak from personal experience and talk in much greater detail about their religion. They will lead a whole school assembly, sharing elements of their lifestyle/beliefs with the children. All children will then participate in workshops where they will have the opportunity to ask questions, look at artefacts and share discussions with each other and the visitor. The purpose is to educate and learn about the experience of a person of faith.

The visits are organised as follows: 15th March – Hinduism with Year 5/6 and EYFS, 4th May – Islam with Year 1/2 and Year 3/4, 15th June – Sikhism with Year 1/2 and Year 3/4.
