Anchorsholme junior parkrun is a super event that has been taking place since September 2021. It is a well marshalled 2 kilometre course (2 laps of 1km), and it welcomes children from ages 4-14 (parents are more than welcome to run/jog/skip with their child if needed, but it is also a safe event for your child to participate on their own with parents as spectators)

There is a mass warm-up at 8.55 am outside the Brew cafe, with the event starting at 9 am.

Theo has now participated in Junior Parkrun 70 times and has volunteered 30 times too. Since taking part, he has become much more confident and fitter, which has also positively affected his football and swimming.

The event is free; you just need to register once and bring your barcode along (phone/watch barcodes can now be scanned too!) Is your child worried about finishing last? They don't need to be! There is a tail walker at each event, so you would never finish last. Are you worried that your child can't run 2km? Don't be! They can run, jog, and walk as they please.
