Week beginning the 10th July ~ Transition week in new classes.

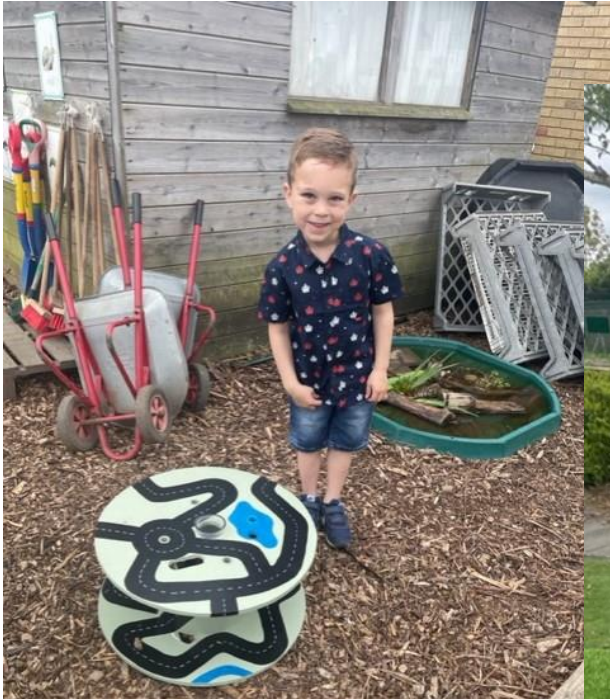
