Next week we have our last week of hosting just our Critical Worker group of children in school; with Mrs Catterall in Ducklings, Mrs Jones in KS1, Mr Vaughan in Lower KS2 and Mrs Bagwell and Mrs Billington in Upper KS2. Please only use this facility if you have no alternative provision.

When the children return on the 8th March they are each to have their usual teacher and will receive their learning in their normal learning spaces alongside their peers. We have been thrilled with the extent of learning and engagement that has been taking place since Christmas and are confident that following some quick assessments we can hit the ground running.

The timings for our school day and locations for picking up and dropping off are to remain as before:

We would like to encourage parents to leave the school grounds as quickly as possible and so there will be staff supervising the gates at the beginning of each day. Facemasks are to be worn during dropping off and picking up times.

Parents' evenings ran well via zoom again and we thank you all for your patience in making this as smooth a process as possible. The children have done remarkably well and we are very pleased with their attitudes towards their learning.

Next week is the annual World Book Day. We would love to dedicate the day to the love of reading so please think about a favourite character or book to share with your friends. Children are invited to dress up (those at home as well as those in school). Every adult in school will have recorded a story online for your children to listen to and enjoy. These will be accessible via our website. Vouchers towards a book will be distributed on the 8th.

The process for this new play area will involve our children co-designing the space with a team of playground specialists. 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to our school grounds. We are lucky to receive sports premium to fund such projects and always try to invest this money in aspects that will provide opportunities for physical exercise for many years to come.
