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All pupils have been able to participate in our Outdoor Learning Sessions this past half term with Mrs Hicks. We really want to improve our outdoor spaces and so ask that if you are able to spare a few hours on the 13th November (10:00-13:00) that you join us in developing them further. It was such a shame that our plastic bottle greenhouse was vandalised as not only had the chidlren worked hard to get it made but it was used every day. Relocating it to the front of the school in a more prominent position will hopefully prevent a repeat destruction. It will also mean that it can be accessed more easily from The Wing (our outdoor learning centre). The play area outside Ducklings is currently being re designed where we hope to have new play equipment installed in the February half term break.

The pumpkin designs that have been brought in today have been tremendous. We have some incredibly creative children! It has been lovely to have had them judged today by 'Helping Hands' and our Art Lead teacher at the end of a busy half term. We hope you all enjoy the two week break.
