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**Doing things for others:**

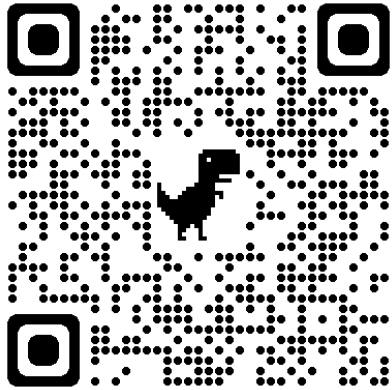

Our application was reviewed and this was our report:

Great work! We love seeing the photo's of the children in action. We love that you have shared the Environmental Review with the whole school community as well as having a copy in the outdoor learning area, well done on early informing and sharing (Step 5)! COVID has obviously caused massive disruption to your plans, but despite this you have made a difference and flourished - we can't wait to see what you achieve in the future, when hopefully there is a lot less

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disruption! It's really clear that your actions were entirely focused on engaging young people in environmental action, empowering them to protect our planet! This is what the Eco-Schools programme is all about! Make sure you carry over any ongoing actions onto next year's Action Plan and update your progress. We love the class mini compost bins idea! We love how you have included soil knowledge as a curriculum link, this reminded me of the quote 'If you give a person a fish, you feed him for a day'. Well done for feeding your children for life!
