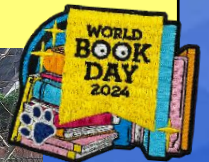

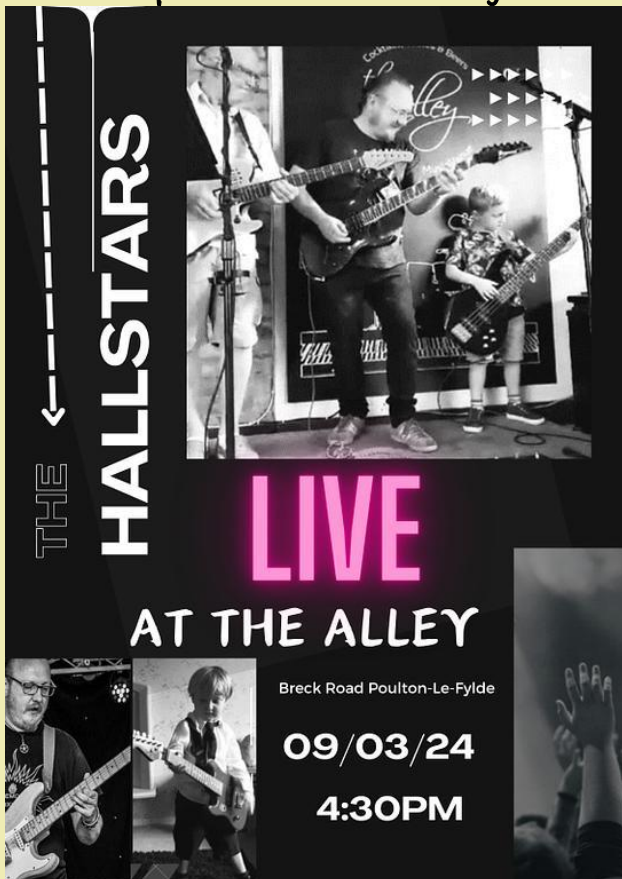
Netball

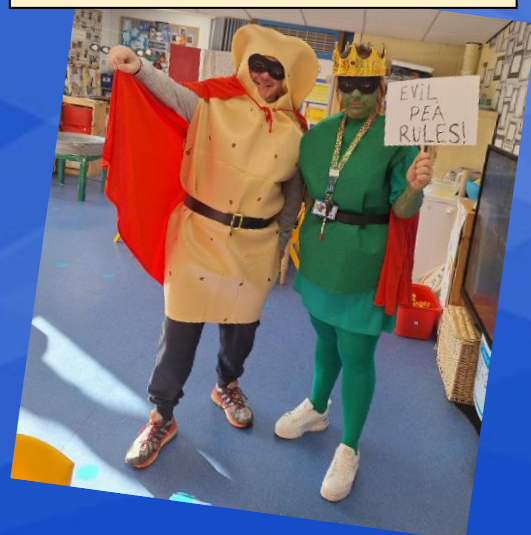
