Blake came away with 2 bronze medals for individual kata and paired kata and Ben won bronze for his team kata.

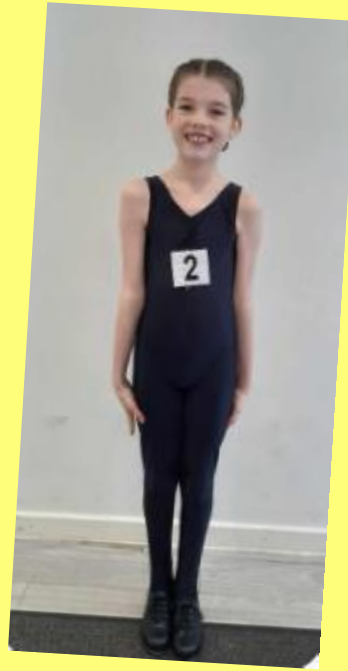
They also had to compete against each other in a medal match for the first time.
