There were 52 teams competing within the cup, so this is a massive achievement.

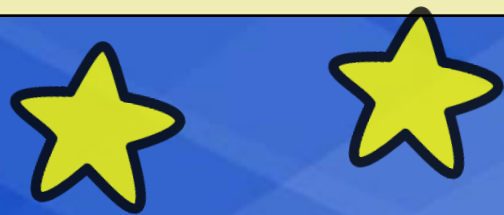
