The Great British Beach Clean is a week-long citizen science event, where hundreds of beach cleans take place up and down the UK. Every year in September, we run our flagship Great British Beach Clean event to encourage people to get involved.

Litter data, collected on beach cleans, drives our conservation work, helps us to campaign for change, and also feeds into the [International Coastal Clean-up](#) (ICC). Our data has been used to make a positive impact on our ocean - including the introduction of the plastic bag charge, banning microplastics in personal care products, better wet wipe labelling, and supporting a tax on single-use plastic items.

But there is still so much to do to stop the litter plaguing our beaches!
