This week...

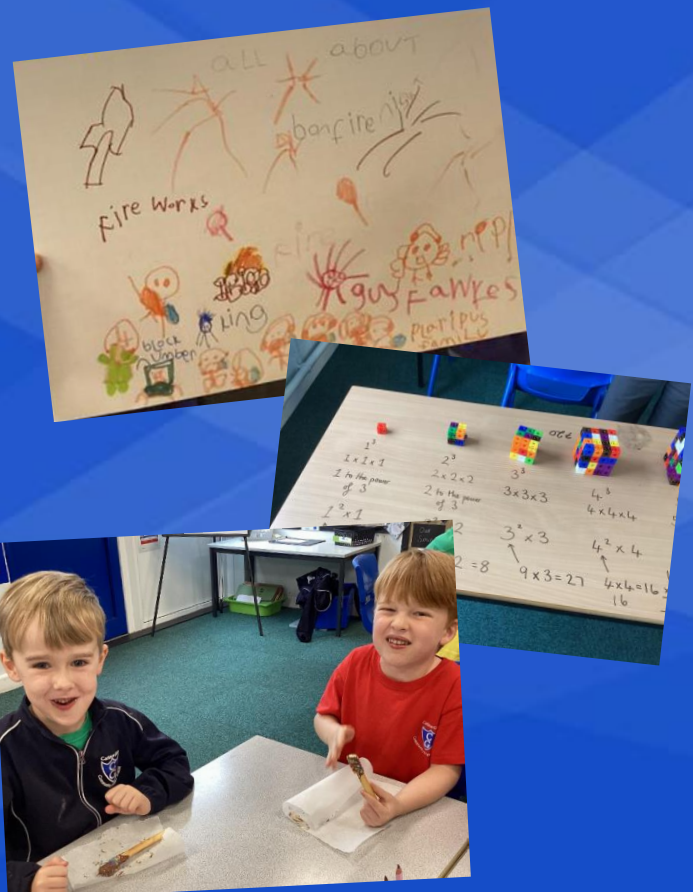
Week 2 of Autumn Term 2 and the children have been hard at work, yet again!
