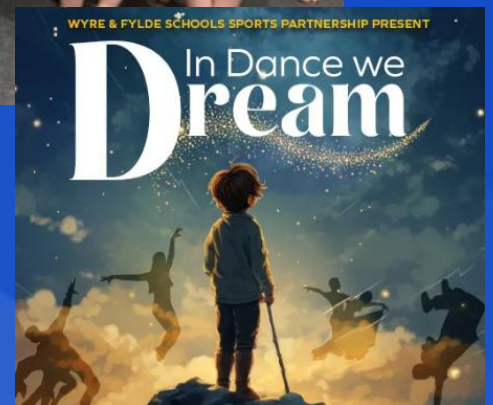
Wednesday 10th December at 6pm.

Healthy Snacks in School

Supporting Healthy Habits: A Reminder About School Snacks

We are committed to promoting the health and well-being of all our children, and this includes ensuring they have sustained energy throughout the school day to support their learning.

We kindly ask for your support in upholding our Healthy Snack Policy by choosing nutritious options for your child's mid-morning or afternoon snack.

What Makes a Healthy Snack?

The best snacks provide a good source of fibre and vitamins without high amounts of added sugar, saturated fat, or salt. These foods provide the best, long-lasting energy.

Please choose one of the following options for your child's daily snack:

Recommended Snack Options
Fresh Fruit: Apples, bananas, grapes, mandarins, sliced melon, berries.
Vegetables: Carrot sticks, cucumber slices, bell pepper strips, cherry tomatoes.
Plain Dairy/Protein: Low-sugar yogurt pots/pouches, cheese cubes/sticks.
Plain Whole Grain: Unsweetened rice cakes, or plain wholemeal crackers.
Water is the only recommended drink for the classroom.

A Critical Allergy Reminder

Please be reminded that we are a Nut-Free School. For the safety of children with severe allergies, do not send any snacks containing nuts, including peanut butter, Nutella, or mixed trail mix.

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We highly value the strong partnership we have with you and appreciate your engagement through ClassDojo. This platform is a wonderful tool to support communication and share positive moments from the classroom. To ensure it remains an effective and sustainable resource for all, we kindly ask for your cooperation in adhering to the following guidelines regarding messaging and response times.

Teacher Availability and Response Times

Please remember that our teachers are fully dedicated to teaching and caring for the children during the school day.

- Our teachers are in the classroom and actively teaching between 8:55 AM and 3:30 PM.
- Messages sent during this time will generally not be seen until after the teaching day has concluded.
- We understand the impulse to send a message when you think of it, but please be aware that messaging a teacher during the school day and then being upset when they haven't seen it is not productive.

We kindly request that you do not expect a response to non-urgent messages sent between 8:45 AM and 3:45 PM.

Urgent Communications (Change of Pick-up, Emergencies)

ClassDojo is not the appropriate channel for urgent messages.

- Change to Pick-Up Arrangements: If you need to communicate a change to your child's end-of-day pick-up arrangements (e.g., they are being collected by a different person, or are going to an after-school club instead of home), this is considered an urgent message, please call the school office directly. Teachers will not be able to check their messages for this critical information.

First Aid Notices

Occasionally, you may receive a notification about a minor injury or First Aid administered to your child.

- These notices are sent by First Aid staff solely to inform you that a minor incident has occurred (e.g., a small bump, a scraped knee).
- Please do not reply to these First Aid messages. The staff member who sent the notice will not be monitoring replies as they are often attending to other children or duties.
- In the event of an emergency or a more serious injury, we will always contact you directly via phone call immediately.

A Final Note on Usage

ClassDojo is provided to support our communication. If the platform is consistently misused (e.g., sending repeated non-urgent messages during school hours, demanding immediate responses, or using it for communication that should go through the office), we will be forced to review its use and may have to discontinue the platform entirely.
