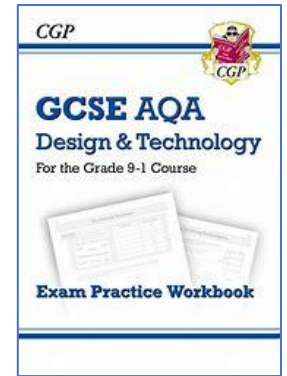
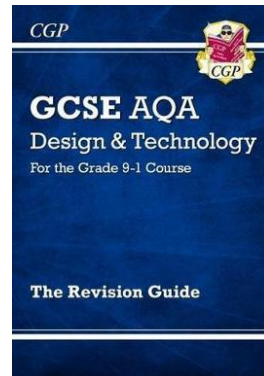
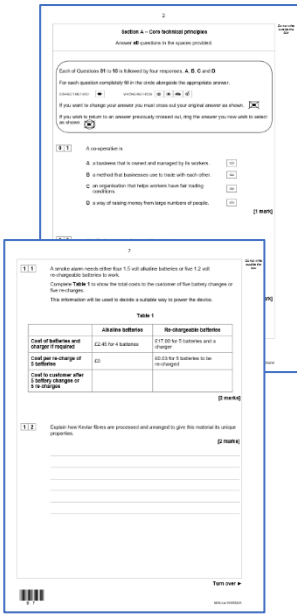
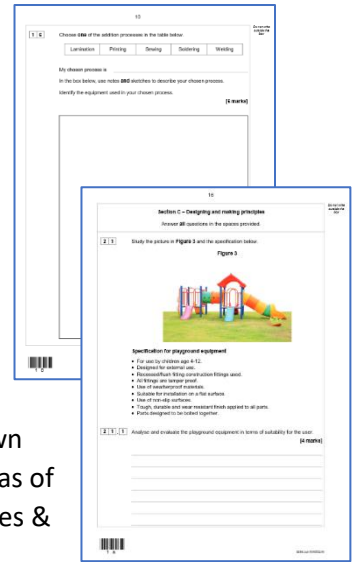
We use the exam board AQA, the exam part of the course is worth 50% of the overall grade.

The exam is broken into sections; multichoice questions, short answer questions and a small number of essay type questions. Maths questions are included in the paper, and can take the form of working out percentages, costing, areas & sizes, reading graphs or interpreting data.

Although many exam questions allow pupils to choose their own material specialism to focus on, the specification covers all areas of Design Technology including; CAD, Electronics, Graphics, Textiles & Resistant Materials so pupils must be coherent in all areas.

We recommend buying both the revision guide and workbook, available from the library, which will be used in class time revision sessions.
