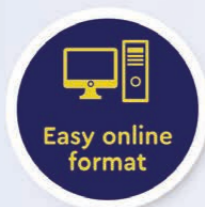

Funding & Bursaries

National support for maintenance and fees are available. The cost of the ITT course is £9,250; applicants are able to apply to Student Loans Company to cover the costs of tuition fees and for a maintenance loan for living costs.
