<p>Calculators must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Of a size suitable for use on the exam desk; • Either battery or solar powered; • Free of lids, cases and covers which have printed instructions or formulae on. 	<p>Calculators must not:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be designed or adapted to offer any of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Language translators; • Symbolic algebra manipulation; • Communication with other machines or the internet; • Be borrowed from another candidate during the examination for any reason; • Have retrievable information stored in them. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Databanks; • Dictionaries; • Mathematical formulae; • Text.
<p>You are responsible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The calculator's power supply; • The calculator's working condition; • Clearing anything stored in the calculator.
