

## Fantasy Adventure Writing!

### PROJECT OUTCOME

This project has an internal outcome where the children will be sharing their learning with Early Years

This project will be for 6 weeks and the children will listen to a story in order to understand character traits, settings and how suspense is created in order to write their own fantasy story.

## English

The children will:



- Listen to and analyse the book Dragon Snatcher
- Create noun phrases, expanded noun phrases and similes
- Understand what adverbs are and where to apply them
- Re-tell the beginning of Dragon Snatcher
- Create their own dilemma and solution and apply them in their own dragon fantasy story

## D.T.

The children will:



- Design their own dragon push/pull toy
- Use a drill to form a hole in 4 wheels ready or an axle
- Use a hacksaw to cut an axle to size
- Assemble and demonstrate their toy

## Art

The children will:



- Explore different clay manipulation techniques
- Create a textured and smooth dragon's eye
