Your involvement in our school community is invaluable, and we greatly appreciate all of your support.



Early Years

This week the children have been learning all about Emperor penguins. They have looked at the life-cycle and written sentences about what they have found out, using a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.

In maths we have been learning all about the number 6. The children have had lots of fun making their hexagon monsters and finding out different ways of making 6.

Next week we are going to be writing some fact pages for our class books, to help our explorer Emily Snow. We will also be continuing our 'Magic Ride' by visiting China. We are very excited to start learning a Chinese New Year song and dragon dance.

New phonics sounds have come home today in zippy wallets. Please have a look at them with your child to help them remember them. We would like to ask for your help with the children's independence when dressing. We are encouraging them to try and turn their clothes in the right way around when dressing and undressing for PE and putting on their socks or tights. Any practise at home with this would really help them in class when changing. We are also working on zips on coats and many of the children are working collaboratively to help one another.

Year 1

This week the children have started their puppet making journey by making 'mock ups' of their puppet design. They have worked very hard to make sure that their mock ups look just like their design. In project writing this week the children have learnt about alliteration which they will be using in their story writing e.g. 'trip trap, clip clop...'. We are continuing to encourage independence in writing by using resources that can be found around the classroom such as the learning walls and tricky word walls.

In maths this week the children have compared numbers within 20 by using words such as greater than, less and equal to whilst using the corresponding symbols. They have also revisited ordering numbers from greatest to smallest. Next week we will be moving on to addition within 20.

Just a reminder that the children's home learning for our 'Showtime' project is to design and create a puppet at home. This can be any type of puppet, if you have any questions or need any help with ideas feel free to bring this up with your class teacher!

Year 2

This week in our Iceberg Ahead project, the children wrote sentences using the subordinating conjunctions 'that' and 'when'. E.g The people cheered when the Titanic set off. The newspaper said that the ship was huge. We also discussed what a 'maiden voyage' is.

Next week in our project, we will start to think about chronology, the order of when events happened, when the Titanic sank. The children will also write a diary entry using a variation of conjunctions e.g. and, but, because, so, and or, as well as use the first person 'I' in their writing.

In maths next week, children will be starting a new unit on multiplication and division. Please can you practice counting in 2's, 10's and 5's with your child.

On Thursday, all children were given a cardboard box. Each box will be a part of our Titanic display in the corridor. Each box will be given part of the Titanic ship e.g. 1st class room, 2nd class dining, engine room. We have attached some pictures of previous years for some inspiration. Your child can be as creative as they like and use different media to create their room. Just a reminder that we would like all of the boxes to be in by the 6th February.
