Geography



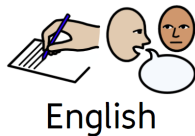
The children will:

- Identify different locations using a map.
- Investigate what human and physical geography is and identify the features around the area.
- Program beebots to move North, South, East and West.
- Map a route to walk around the local area and label different things they find.

English

The children will:

- Write sentences about the area they live in using conjunctions to add more detail.
- Add suffixes -ing, -ed, -es/-s to the end of words.
- Interview some local residents of Winklebury to find out more information.



History

The children will:

- Discuss the history of Winklebury and how it has changed.
- Order images of Winklebury throughout time.
- Create an exhibition to teach others about Winklebury's changes.
