

English

Children will begin with writing some facts about themselves to produce a fact file. They will use kinetic letters handwriting, finger spaces, full stops and capital letters at the beginning of a sentence. Children will develop their sentence structures and will think out loud before writing their sentence.

PSHE

Children will take part in circle times to develop their turn taking skills as well as expressing their own thoughts and feelings. We will also discuss school rules and develop our own classroom charter which the children will decide on. We will focus a lot on emotions and how we can talk about our feelings. We will also talk about we can manage our big emotions.

Through song and rhymes children will identify different body parts such as hand, leg, eyes and mouth. Children will draw a picture of themselves and label these body parts.
