<u>English</u>

Children will be introduced to Stanley the red plastic carrier bag and other characters from the book Someone Swallowed Stanley. They will then write descriptive sentences about the characters. The children will be introduced to adjectives and how they can be used to make their writing even more interesting. They will use kinetic letters handwriting, finger spaces, full stops and capital letters at the beginning of a sentence. Children will develop their sentence structures and will think out loud before writing their sentence.

Stanley Saves the Seas

Science

In science the children will look at the plastic as a material, the uses and disadvantages of using plastic. They will begin to explore different materials such as paper and metal, looking at their properties and what that can be used for.

The children will create collage artwork in the style of Jane Perkins. They will explore different materials such as magazines, plastic and fabric to create their underwater collage.
