Early Years

We have had such a great week exploring the parts of a plant this week! We have been busy writing instructions on how to plant a bean which we are excited to share with you later in our project. We have also been making careful observations and drawing some plants, thinking about shading with our pencil too.

Next week we will be thinking about the weather, planting some class cress and watching it grow. In maths we will be looking at the number 4, squares, rectangles and sorting shapes into those with 4 sides and not 4 sides. In phonics we will be starting our Phase 3 sounds in phonics with j,v,w and x. Next week is also National Road Safety week so we will be spending an afternoon learning about how to keep safe by the roads and how to cross safely.

A couple of reminders that Oxford Owl log ins are in the back of your child's reading and home learning diary. This gives you access to extra books online if you would like to use them. This week the children have found out more to do with The Great Fire of London as part of our Fire! Fire! Project. They have learnt about the fire service, or lack of, back in 1666. They have discussed the various

equipment that was used and have made their own zig-zag books as part of this week's writing tasks. Next week, in our project work, the children will find out about King Charles II and how he helped with the fire. They may even have two special visitors!

This week in maths, the children have continued their shape work. They have made their own 3D and 2D model, then labelled them with the shape names. Next week in maths we will recap addition and subtraction, reminding children the different strategies that can be used to solve these problems.
