This week in Year 1 the children have taken on a roleplay activity for our project. They re-enacted a conversation between King Charles II and Samuel Pepys deciding to use gunpowder to stop the fire. The children then wrote out a conversation in speech bubbles, creating their own questions using question marks. Today for our project we began to explore different shapes and colours of flames and experimented creating art using watercolour and oil pastels.

In maths, we have been learning to draw and label our own number lines! The children then used their number lines to work out both addition and subtraction number sentences.
