We will also be starting our maths, looking at

matching and sorting. The children will be very good at pairing matching socks by the end of the week so make sure to use them to help at home!

# Winklebury Way - Carriageway Resurfacing works

We have been informed by Hampshire County Council that throughout September they will be carrying out carriageway resurfacing works in Winklebury way, Basingstoke from Ashwood Way roundabout to the junction of Dover Close.

The works will take place in 2 Phases;

Phase 1 (Night time works) will start on the 12<sup>th</sup> September to 18<sup>th</sup> September and the road will be closed off between the hours of 22:00 – 06:00.

Phase 2 (day time works) will begin on the 19<sup>th</sup> September to 27<sup>th</sup> September and the road will be closed off between the hours of 07:30 – 18:00.
