Aim of the Course: To help prepare you and your child for a successful start in Year R in September.

Learning Goals By the end of course you will be able to:-

- 1. Describe how routines at school can help my child access their learning more efficiently.
- 2. Describe by role as a parenting in supporting the YR curriculum.
- 3. To prepare games I can use at home to support my child with their routines, Maths, Reading and Writing.
- 4. To identify areas where I feel my child may need more support before starting school.
- 5. To discover how assessment informs my child's progress and describe what I can do to support their next steps.
- 6. To describe how coping strategies can help support my child's potential anxiety around starting school.

About the Course: Your tutor is a qualified Primary School Teacher who has worked in Early Years and Key Stage 1 for 6 years. This course is designed to give you confidence in supporting your child's transition to school.

Who is this course for? The course is for any parent, guardian or carer who has a child starting primary school in September.
