Dear Parents and Friends of Castle Hill,

Key Reminders for Parents

- All children will return to school on Tuesday 3rd September, with exception of Year R.

- A reminder that the school day will end at 3:15 pm
- School attendance continues to be a priority. Every parent has a legal responsibility to ensure their child/ren is in school and we expect <u>all</u> children to be in school on Tuesday 3rd September. There will be further information about our Attendance Policy.
- Punctual arrival is expected and your child/ren should be in class ready for registration. If your child is late for school, they will need to sign-in via reception.
- To avoid traffic congestion around the school, where possible, please walk to school. Scooting and riding bikes are encouraged. If children are leaving them on site they will be stored at the bike rack. Children need to be able to park and secure them independently.
- We have a strict Uniform Policy and all children will be expected to wear full school uniform. For health and safety reasons we do not allow pupils to wear earrings or any jewellery -https://www.castlehillprimary.net/policies/uniform-personal-belongings
- On PE days, your child can come to school wearing their PE uniform, the choice is yours. Please make sure that, if the weather is cold or damp, your child's PE kit is suitable for the weather, and they also have a coat. - Please label EVERYTHING, including water bottles which need bringing in daily.

- Pupils in years 3 to 6 are allowed to bring a healthy break-time snack. Nut free please!
- Please make sure you can use SCOPay/Tucasi (the online payment system) to pre-order your child's meal where possible. Please keep your meal account in credit.
