

Sports Day 2022 - Rooksdown

Dear Parents and Friends of Castle Hill,

Sports Day is fast approaching! It is scheduled for **Friday 17**th **June.** Parents are welcome to arrive from **09:45** and the activities will commence from **10:00**; please find attached the schedule for the day. If it rains, the **alternative day will be Thursday 14**th **July 2022** at the same time. **Please ensure that your child is dressed in full PE Kit.** Please remember to stay **behind the barriers** and move in a **clockwise rotation** around the playground and field.

After Sports Day (approx. 12:00) there will be an opportunity for you and your family to join your child/ren and have a family picnic on the school field - or in your child's classroom if it is raining. After the family picnic, we will be holding our Summer Fayre (approx. 13:00) organised by The Fundraising Friends. There will be a letter from them to give you more information in due course. If Sports Day is postponed, the Summer Fayre will also be postponed.

The children are able to order a school picnic lunch for Sports Day that will be enjoyed on the field with all pupils. The alternative is for the children (and yourselves!) to bring in a packed lunch from home. We do ask that your picnic contains no nuts, due to allergies, and no alcohol. If your child is in KS2 and receives Free School Meals, they are able to order a meal for the day. If your child is in EYFS or KS1, they will be able to order their Free School Meal as normal.

The school picnic lunch will be a Fish Finger Roll or Veggie Sausage in a bap (served with veggie sticks, shortbread biscuit and fruit). If you would like your child to have a school picnic you need to pre-order this on Scopay, selecting 'M' for Fish Fingers or 'V' for Veggie Sausage. Your choices need to be received by Friday 10th June. Due to ordering of food, no picnic choices will be accepted after this date and you will need to make alternative arrangements for your child's food.

Should you wish to collect your child at the end of Sports Day, we will be asking you to collect your child from the normal classroom door. The children from **that point on will be your responsibility**. We need to stress the importance of knowing whether or not you will be signing your child out, as we will need to allocate them a staff member to be with until normal pick up time of 15:00. (Highly important for ratio purposes).

If you are unable to attend, your child will still be able to have a picnic outside with their packed lunch or picnic choice. Please can you let us know if you are not attending so that we can organise enough staffing for the group.

Please can you complete the Google form to indicate your attendance / collection arrangements by **Friday 10th June**.

If the weather is bad on sports day, your picnic choice will be moved to the reserved sports day. We will make a decision on Thursday as to whether Sports Day will go ahead or not, so you will know in advance.
